Route Description

Lake Constance International Bicycle Path

To begin your tour around Lake Constance, you should know that there are three main cities established along this route: Bregenz, the old eponym from the Roman times; Friedrichshafen, the lake's largest city; and Konstanz, the source of the lake's name in French, Italian, and in English.

These towns provide easy accessibility with public transportation; Bregenz has overall the most excellent parking possibilities. In addition, the three cities boast an excellent variety of hotels.

Riding stages around the lake vary. There are a few riders who need ten days to ride around Lake Constance while others manage it in two. This book doesn't apply to speed demons or sport enthusiasts. This bicycle route is one of the most beautiful in Europe and one should enjoy the ride with all five senses.

Stage 1: Bregenz – Rorschach – Arbon (40 km)

From the bicycle distribution station at Hotel Weißes Kreuz, ride to the right through the pedestrian area, and then turn left at the second cross street and ride to the railway gate. Cross the train tracks and make an immediate left into the Lake Constance bicycle path, where you'll ride through the beautiful parklands along the lake. Riding on paved roads will take you to the excellent restaurant "Haus am See", the festival building and lakeside stage, and Hotel Mercure with casino. The path is well marked, and will take you sometimes through passages in active cloisters on your way to Mehrerau. From here, ride along the lake on narrow – yet paved and beautiful – paths which go past countless bathing sites. At the Bregenzer Ach, the main river of the Bregenzer forest and a tributary to Lake Constance, DON'T get confused by the yellow-white signs which say "Bodenseeweg". These signs mark a hiking trail. Please follow the signs which denote the bicycle path.

You will then ride 1 kilometer upstream along the Bregenzer Ach to the bridge. Use the bicycle lane to cross the bridge to Hard, the next Lake Constance community in Austria. Here, you'll ride to the sailboat docks
